

Post-COVID-19 Physical Space and Operations to Reduce Risk of Infection

4/29/20

After each patient visit:

1. Treatment rooms will be treated with antibacterial spray
2. Ultrasound and Cold Laser applicators will be disinfected with antibacterial spray
3. Fresh pillow cases applied to pillows
4. Gowns will be laundered
5. Hand Table will be disinfected with antibacterial spray
6. Equipment will be sanitized.

Hourly:

1. Reception area door handles inside and outside will be disinfected with antibacterial spray.
2. Reception chair seats will be vacuumed and chair handles disinfected with antibacterial spray
3. Reception desk and pens will be sprayed with antibacterial spray.

Patient Treatments:

1. Clinicians will wash hands before and after each patient treatment
2. Gloves will be worn by clinicians during manual therapy
3. Masks will be worn by clinicians and patient. If patients do not have a mask, they will be given a bandana.
4. Patients encouraged to complete new patient paperwork prior to coming into clinic
5. Patient appointments adjusted to minimize overlap time
6. Patients will not use the same sign-in pen. Sign-in sheet affirms absence of fever and avoidance of high risk travel.
7. With the exception of minors and required caregivers, only patients will be in the clinic

Bathrooms:

1. Daily thorough cleaning of bathrooms with sanitizers and disinfectants

Staff:

1. All staff will perform proper hand hygiene frequently after touching surfaces and patients.
